Color Me Chili

Ingredients:

- 2 tablespoons butter
- 3 tablespoons canola oil
- 2 red bell peppers, diced
- 2 yellow bell peppers, diced
- 2 jalapenos, minced
- 3 poblano chilies, diced
- 2 yellow onions, diced
- 1 head garlic, minced
- 2 pounds ground beef
- 1 pound Italian sausage
- 2 teaspoons granulated onion
- 2 teaspoons granulated garlic
- 3 tablespoons chili powder
- 2 teaspoons hot paprika
- 2 teaspoons ground cumin
- 2 teaspoons ground coriander
- 2 teaspoons cayenne pepper
- 2 teaspoons kosher salt
- 2 teaspoons freshly ground black ground pepper
- 2 cups tomato sauce
- 1 cup tomato paste
- 1 cup chicken stock
- 2 cans pinto beans, with juice
- 2 cans kidney beans, with juice
