Open letter to Lind-Bohanon neighbors from the new LBNA Chairperson David Barnett,



*Dear Neighbors,
There comes a time in life when you just have to get involved!
I first got involved with the Lind-Bohanon Neighborhood Association last year by attending a couple of their monthly meetings to find out what was going on. Then I volunteered at their community-wide events like Picnic in the Park, Heritage Day and then served as a board member last year. It was kind of eye opening to see how much this fun group of neighbors is doing for our community and how successful they are! But it wasn't all the great things LBNA is doing that made me want to be the LBNA Board Chair this year, it was what the tremendous amount of needs our community has and the tremendous opportunity we have to be able to help right in our own neighborhood by taking part in LBNA.*

Revolving Loan Program

- *4% fixed rate financing
- *15,000 maximum loan
- *NO MAXIMUM Income Limit

Eligible improvements include most interior and exterior maintenance and remodeling.

MN Fix-Up Fund Program

- *Below market, fixed rate
- *\$35,000 maximum loan
- *Flexible terms

Eligible improvements include: windows, doors, siding, garages, kitchens, new additions, flooring and more!

CEE Home Energy Loan Program

- *Fixed rate
- *NO MAXIMUM income limit
- *\$10,000 maximum loan

Eligible improvements include: windows, doors, furnaces, A/C, insulation, water heaters and boilers.
